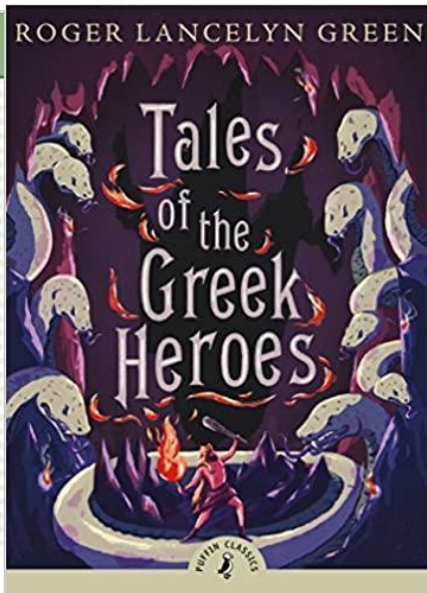
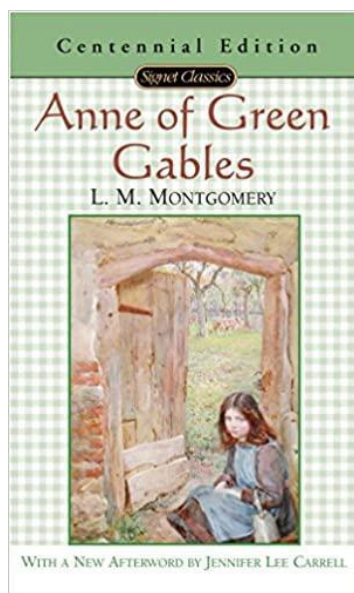
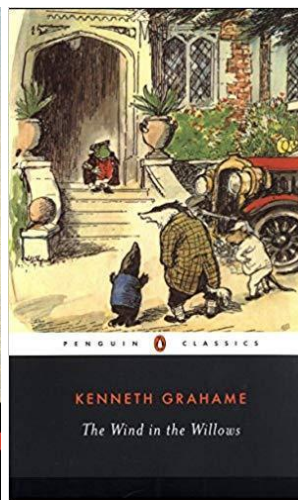
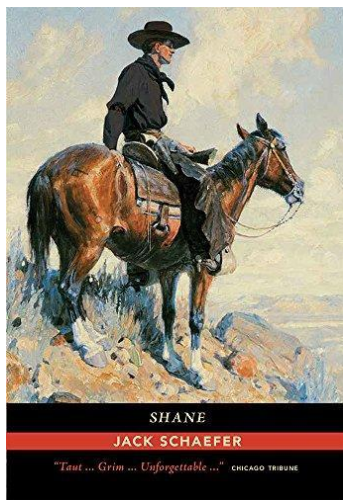
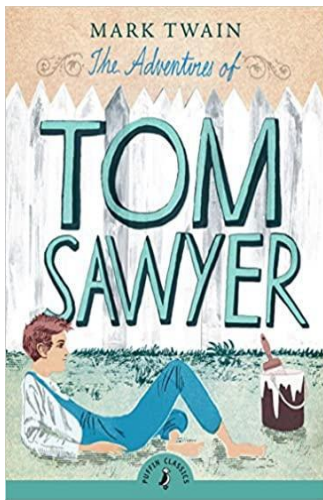
Dear Great Hearts Forest Heights Parents,

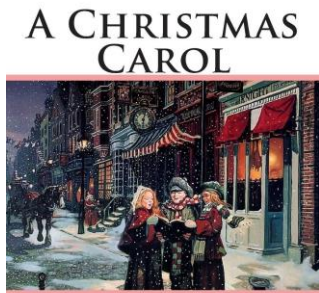

Below is a list of the “Classics to Keep” along with the specific ISBN’s for each text, which will enable to class to easily refer to a page number or a specific passage during discussions.

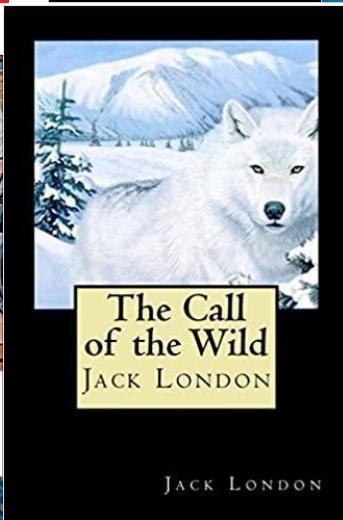
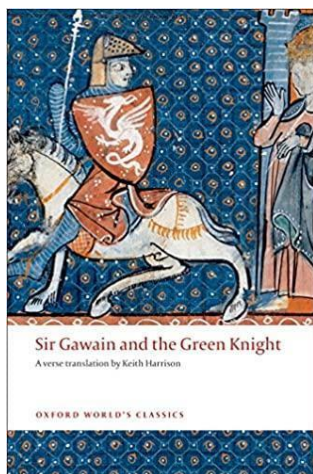
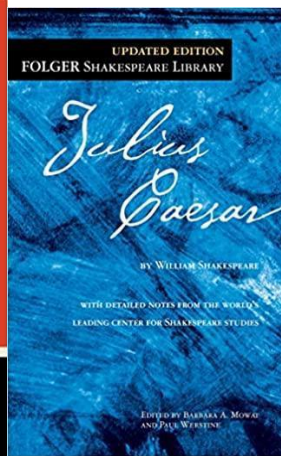
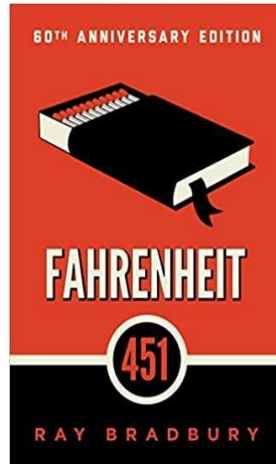
